



On November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 00:00Z, seven full scale cockpit simulators will depart Sydney Australia[YSSY] heading in a westerly direction on the start of a seven day journey raising money for several worthwhile charities. The seven full sized cockpit simulators are members of the WORLDFLIGHT GROUP [WFG] [www.worldflightgroup.com](http://www.worldflightgroup.com) and will visit 45 cities and traverse some 33,700nm arriving back in Sydney seven days later on November 8<sup>th</sup> at 0820Z.
